Asylum Seekers from Myanmar, Sri Lanka and Bangladesh.
we are staying in Indonesia from long times. Some of us
here in more than a years, some are 6 month by the
support and register of UNHCR.

we leave of our country, our family only because of
the political violence, mass killings and not safety of our
life. that's why we lived Indonesia from a long time.
and we expect a peaceful life.

That's why we took a huge risk and made journey from
Indonesia to New Zealand. we hoped that may we get a
peaceful life. There, because we heard that New Zealand
is a peaceful country.

Unfortunately we caught by the Australian Navy and by the
Border protection Soldiers in International water area and
Sent back to Indonesia.

Now we are in Kupang a detention center from near 3 months.
we and our family is really in under pressure now because
we never expect this kind of life.

Before we appealed to New Zealand Government. and After
that the Immigration minister of New Zealand Michael
Woodhouse.

Suggested us by the media that make contact with the
UNHCR High Commission in Canberra.

After that we already sent our request to Canberra. and
also in Jakarta UNHCR Branch.

That's why we request you that, Sir please do something
for our painful life any give us a chance for living a
peaceful life we believe that you can do that.
